Some examples and clarification for data entry as follows. These may seem simple, but many forms are incomplete.

- 1. The "Total # of Nestboxes Available" should not be less than the "Total # of Nestboxes Used".
- 2. The "# of Boxes Used" by the individual "Cavity Nesting Species" may not be equal to the "Total # of Nestboxes Used" at the top of the form. (i.e. I have 3 nestboxes, all are used by bluebirds on the first nesting, a pair of swallows then nests after one of the bluebirds; my "Total # of Nestboxes Used" is 3 but if I add the "# of Boxes Used" by the individual "Cavity Nesting Species" it will total 4)
- 3. The "# of Boxes Used" by the individual "Cavity Nesting Species" should not include in the number of boxes that had a second nestings. (i.e. a nestbox is used by Western Bluebirds, they lay 5 eggs, all hatch & all fledge; there is a second nesting of Western Bluebirds in that same box; they lay 4 eggs, all hatch & fledge; you enter 1 box used, 9 eggs, 9 hatched, 9 fledged,1 second nesting.) Remember that second nestings in a box by the same species may not be the same pair.
- 4. Check that your form is complete. Many times the "Total # of Nestboxes Available" is left blank. When compiling the data your previous year's form is not used so the # of boxes is unknown. You may also have lost a nestbox to predators over the winter or revamped your trail and this of course alters your numbers.
